Wharton Junior High Plan: Face to Face

Arrival:

Faculty & Staff: Morning Plan

1. Single point entry will continue via the Life Skills entrance.
2. Daily temperature check and recorded on arrival.
3. Face masks will be enforced for all faculty and staff.

Students: Morning staging for students arriving before 7:30 A.M

1. 7th Graders in the cafeteria.
2. 8th Graders in the Old gym.
3. New gym will be used for overflow.
4. WJH students are required to wear a mask.

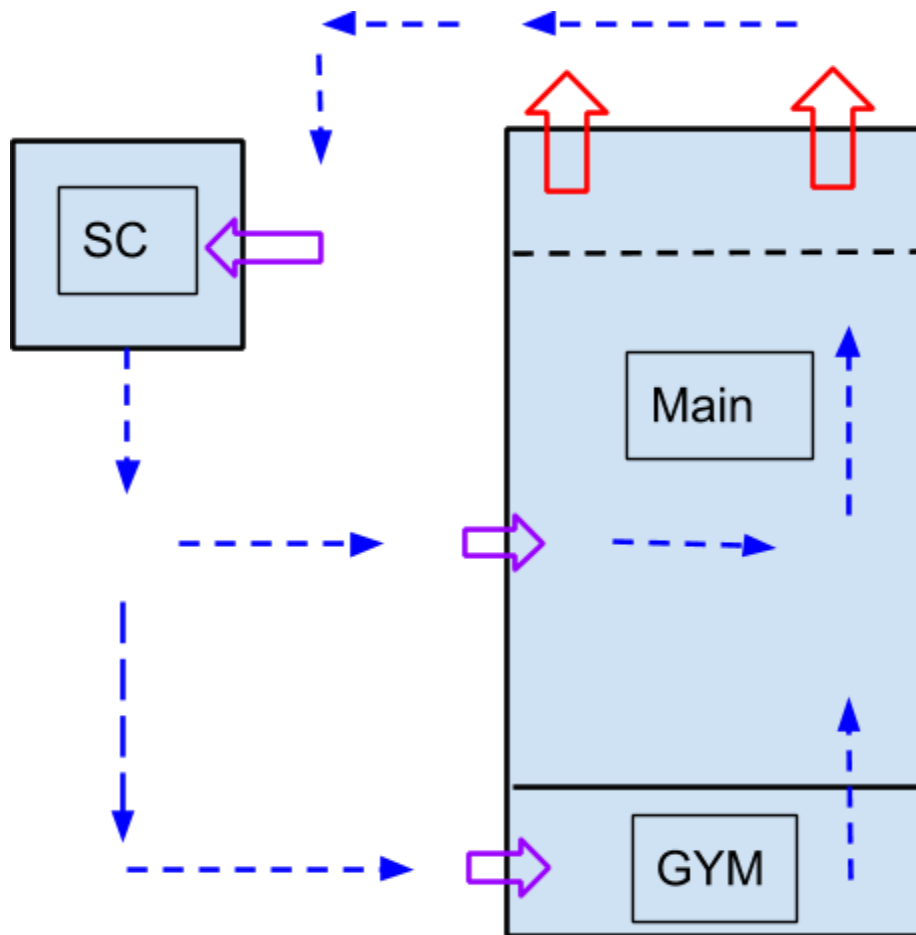


Transition:

We have created six zones for effective contra flow transition between class periods.

Three zones will be released simultaneously in order of (1, 2 & 3) and (4, 5, & 6).

1. One way traffic pattern around the campus during exchange of classes.
 - 8th grade zone released in a single line via the back door, turn East and loop round into the Science building.
 - The Science building will be released class by class in a single line through the back door and enter the main building using the middle door turning left and travel South.
 - The basement zone released next into the hallway forming a line going travelling South.
 - The Library and the Special Education zone will be released through the double door, turn East and enter the Science building or enter the main building through the middle door, turn left and travel South.
 - 2nd floor students will be released following the down staircase into the double door, turn East and either go to the Science building or enter the main building using the middle door, turn left and travel South in a single line.
 - P.E students will be released last into the rotation.



Sanitation:

Staff will wipe down door handles, students' desks within the classrooms and common areas between each passing period with district issued sanitizers.



Restroom Breaks:

Students will be required to sign the restroom folder in each classroom when going to the restroom.

Wharton Junior High Breakfast and Lunch Plan:

Breakfast:

1. 7th Grade in the Cafeteria.
2. 8th Grade in the Old/New gym.
3. Outside benches will be used as overflow.



Lunch: Two lunches will be served in the cafeteria. The campus will not allow fast food lunch to be delivered to students during this period.

1. 7th Grade lunch using the old gym as the overflow.
2. 8th Grade lunch using the old gym as the overflow.

Dismissal:

Students will remain in their classes and wait for a gradual release starting with:

1. Car Riders - Exit the building via the main entrance to the parent pick up area.
2. Bus Riders :
The cafeteria will be the staging area when students are called for release using bus numbers. The next group will enter the cafeteria after the departure of the former group and the rotation continues until we are down to the last bus.

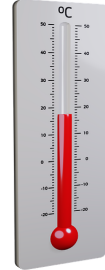

Arrival:

Faculty and Staff

1. Single point entry for Faculty and staff.
2. Temperature will be taken & recorded for everyone each morning.



Students:

1. Students will go to different locations based on their grade level.
2. We will stagger release, using contra flow, from these holding locations for students to go to their first period classes.

A) 9th Grade- Cafeteria

B) 10th Grade- Old Gym

C) 11th Grade- New Gym

D) 12th Grade- Auditorium

3. Everyone is required to wear a mask.



Classroom Transition:

1. Teachers have been grouped by the majority of grade level students they teach throughout the day. The moves are color coded and grouped to “zone” the grade levels as best as possible.
 - a. **Green Zone- Freshman**
 - b. **Yellow Zone- Sophomores**
 - c. **Orange Zone- Juniors**

d. Blue Zone- Seniors

e. Fuschia- Mixed Grade Levels

f. Red- CTE/Arts

g. Brown- Athletics

2. Students transitioning to any CTE/Athletics/ROTC/Band classes will have contraflow that will be monitored by faculty & staff. Students going to those classes will use the sidewalk that flows through the courtyard. Students transitioning from those classes will exit the gate in between the old gym & cafeteria and use the sidewalk that runs in front of the old gym into the Freshman hallway.
3. Podding teachers will be coupled with a staggered bell schedule.
 - a. Classes will be dismissed by zones. There will be contraflow in each hallway that provides one way transitioning.
4. **All classrooms will be sanitized during passing periods**
 - a. Staff will wipe down all student desks, chairs, door handles and any other commonly used items.
 - b. Staff will wipe down common area door handles on a scheduled basis.



5. The zones will be released to the three lunches by zone based on teachers' 5th period.

a. Green Zone- Freshman

b. Yellow Zone- Sophomores

c. Orange Zone- Juniors

d. Blue Zone- Seniors

e. Fuschia- Mixed Grade Levels

f. Red- CTE/Arts

g. Brown- Athletics



Restroom Procedures:

1. Signs will be posted on all restrooms doors with restroom regulations.
2. Students will only be allowed to use the restroom in the zone of their present class.

3. Teachers will only allow 1 student out of their room at a time.
 - a. Students will sign in & out each time they leave the room.
 - b. Upon re-entering the room students will sanitize their hands.

Sanitation:

Staff will wipe down door handles, students' desks within the classrooms and common areas between each passing period with district issued sanitizers.



Bus Dismissal/Car Pick Up Dismissal:

1. Students will be dismissed from class according to their zone.
2. Students will stand in designated waiting areas based on their grade level.
 - a. Masks are required on the bus ramp as well as on the bus.
