

2019 – 2020 SES/WES Dressing Guidelines

Dress and Personal Appearance: Final determination of acceptable dress and grooming rests with the principal or his/her designee and cannot be appealed.

Shirts: Shirts must be clean and neat; sleeveless shirt and see-through shirts are not permitted.

Pants/Dresses: No baggy clothing will be allowed; no holes in the pants showing skin or undergarments will be permitted; wind pants and sweat pants are not permitted.

Shorts: Shorts must be within two inches of the top of the knee; athletic or swim-type shorts are not allowed.

Jeans: Sagging, low rise, tight or jeans with holes **will not** be permitted.

Accessories: Boys may have one (1) stud earring in each ear; not excessively long nails, tattoos must not be visible; do not bring sunglasses, hats, caps, sweatbands, do-rags or bandanas to school except upon a physician's order.

Hair: No unnatural hair colors or dyes are permitted for all students; any haircut which is deemed by the administration to be inappropriate in style or design will result in appropriate disciplinary action.

Footwear: Flip Flops or slides may not be worn; shoes must have a back or strap; shoes with retractable rollers are not permitted.

Purses: No larger than 12 inches x 12 inches x 6 inches are allowed; no large beach or tote bags will be allowed to be used as a purse.

Backpacks: Backpacks with wheels will **NOT** be allowed.
